- All fees due from the parents/guardians of any pupil are required on or before the first day of the ensuing term.
- General Data Protection Regulation 2016 (GDPR). Airthrie respects your Data Privacy yet maintain the rights to contact the pupil's previous school to request relevant information about a pupil and to forward information to the DofE and a pupil's future school at any time when requested.
